With his vision and unique photographic style, the book presents a poetic interpretation of the familiar and rarely witnessed scenes in the untamed Everglades and Ten Thousand Islands along with picturesque scenes from Naples and Marco Island, along with narrative text by author and journalist Karen T. Bartlett.

Maltz, the official wildlife and fine art photographer of Florida, will appear at an artist reception from 12:30 to 2:30 p.m. Saturday at Museum of the Everglades and 5:30 to 8 p.m. Nov. 20 at Naples Depot Museum. Books arrive in stores in mid-November or may be ordered through alanmaltz.com.
